The following is a sample Waste Management Plan. It is provided in order to assist you with complying with current Federal law which specifies that United States ocean going vessels of 40 feet or longer which are engaged in commerce or are equipped with a galley and berthing must have a written Waste Management Plan describing the procedure for collecting, precessing, storing, and discharge of waste and designating the person in charge of caring out the plan. It should be customized for your particular vessel and signed by the vessel's Captain then kept aboard at all times.

Waste Management Plan for the

While on-board this vessel please follow these guidelines for handling garbage.

Collect all refuse in bins located in the galley, heads, and staterooms.

As needed, consolidate refuse into trash bags which are to be stored in _____.

Retain refuse until in a harbor where the refuse can be taken ashore and disposed of in accordance with local laws.

Oil and oily bilge water SHALL NOT be discharged upon the navigable waters of the United States at any time.

Garbage may be discharged at sea under specific conditions. Refer to the "Garbage Placard" for those conditions.
